

Education Consultant – PFAS/AFFF Contamination

Since 2003, [SL Environmental Law Group P.C.](#) has been helping public and private agencies affected by contamination in their water, wastewater, biosolids, and soil recover existing or anticipated clean-up costs by shifting the burden to the chemical manufacturers responsible for the pollution. A growing area of focus is per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), including contamination detected by passive receivers such as wastewater treatment facilities, aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF) used at airports, and other sites where PFAS-containing materials may have entered stormwater systems, wastewater streams, soil, groundwater, and landfills.

PFAS contamination can create substantial financial and operational burdens for municipal authorities, airport operators, utilities, and other public entities. Releases from historical AFFF use, training exercises, equipment testing, runoff, wastewater treatment residuals, biosolids management, and disposal practices can lead to costly investigation, monitoring, treatment, and remediation obligations. SL Environmental Law Group uses the legal process to help public entities pursue recovery of those costs from manufacturers and other responsible parties, so that taxpayers and ratepayers are not left to bear the full burden.

We are looking for a consultant to help our education efforts in the state of Pennsylvania, with a particular emphasis on PFAS contamination and related impacts to wastewater, biosolids, and soil. The consultant will collaborate with the SL team to recommend an education strategy based on their experience and manage its execution for the designated region.
