

LEAD WASTEWATER PLANT OPERATOR

The Lower Salford Township Authority located in Harleysville PA, is seeking a full-time licensed lead wastewater plant operator. The Authority operates two activated sludge treatment plants, pump stations and collections system.

The Lead Wastewater Plant Operator position is responsible for the daily operations, maintenance and repairs of the treatment plants, pump stations and collection system to ensure an efficient and safe operation. The position is responsible to supervise and direct the operations staff to ensure compliance with specific regulatory standards and requirements. The position reports to the Authority's Operations Manager.

The individual must be proficient with pump operations, laboratory equipment and instrumentation, chemical feed systems, solids dewatering and control systems. Must be proficient with the use of power and hand tools. Must display the ability to work independently and problem solve.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Pennsylvania Wastewater Operator Certification Class B and E with Subclass 1 and 4 are required.
- Minimum 5-7 years of experience in wastewater operations and 2 years in a supervisory role.
- Valid driver's license.
- Must be able to work weekends, holidays and respond to emergency calls on a rotating schedule.
- Experience with SCADA, GIS, and Microsoft Office skills a plus.
- Knowledge of mechanical systems, plumbing, and electric preferred.

Compensation is commensurate with experience and qualifications.
