

LCA Customer Newsletter Have You Checked Your Home for Lead Pipes?

LCA is asking all customers to complete an online survey to confirm the type of material used for the water service line pipes in your home. Service line pipes enter your property from the street and connect to your water meter. LCA did not previously track this information because the pipes are owned and serviced by the property owner. Customer input is required for LCA to build a complete inventory of pipe materials that connect to the water distribution system. The inventory will be used to meet updated federal regulations, determine future system improvements and prioritization, develop timely stomer communications, and any other action that may be needed in the future.
